



## **Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup> - Dress Rehearsal Information**

The Dress Rehearsal Schedule IS **NOT** the same as the performance line-ups. We are aware that some of you may have conflicts throughout the week. We did our best to accommodate as many students as possible. If you are aware in advance that you are unable to make the rehearsals, please let us know as soon as possible. Arrive at the **Meyer Theatre** @ your class(es) specified time, with all costumes and shoes! Hair and make-up should be done as if it were the actual performance. **Doors for the Dress Rehearsals will open at 4:30pm.** Staff may be in the building, although will not be able to let anyone in earlier than 4:30pm due to Meyer Theatre policy. If your child is in only one performance class, please come dressed in costume and have them change into their dance shoes once at the Meyer Theatre. Please come through the FRONT doors of the Meyer Theatre, and wait in the main seating section (Orchestra seating) until we call your son/daughter's class for stage time. After their performance, on-stage, the students (and parents if you would like) will be shown where their dressing room is located for the performance nights. Once students are finished with all their 'stage times', they are dismissed to their parents in the main auditorium.

Each class will have between 10-15 minutes on stage (except for ballet medleys). This ensures that each class can go through their routine 2 times if need be.

Students can leave after their stage time if they are not scheduled to rehearse on-stage again. Provided our students follow directions and are ready when called, we anticipate things going smoothly. In the past, some of our rehearsals have run early; whereas some classes only needed one run-through. Please be prepared if this happens again. In the event that there may be some snags, which may lengthen our time at rehearsal, please send your child(ren) with homework, puzzles, etc. Please make sure your child's NAME is on all items that are brought. POD and the Meyer Theatre are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

You can videotape your child the day of the rehearsal. There will be **NO** videotaping OR flash photography allowed during the actual shows. POD will have a videographer (Parkway Productions) on hand for ALL the performances so families can simply sit back and enjoy the show(s). DVD's will be for sale following each show and order forms will be available on-site at the Meyer Theatre throughout all the performances.

**PARKING:** Parking is available in the ramp (corner of Washington and Cherry), on the street, or in Chase Bank parking lot. Street and Chase parking are free after 6:00 pm.

## May 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, & 7<sup>th</sup> (Friday-Sunday) – Spring Production Performances

The performance schedule will be posted in the program the day of the recital, as well as on our website a week prior to the recital weekend.

**Friday 6:00pm show:** Dancers arrive between 5:00-5:30pm. Show begins @ 6:00pm.  
Doors Open to the public @ 5:00pm.

**Saturday 12:00pm:** Dancers arrive between 11:00-11:30am. Show begins @ 12:00pm.  
Doors open to the public @ 11:00am. Following the show, the Meyer Theatre needs to be  
**Cleared of all dancers and visitors to prep for the 6:00pm show. Thank you!**

**Saturday 6:00pm show:** Dancers arrive between 5:00-5:30pm. Show begins @ 6:00pm.  
Doors open to the public @ 5:00pm

**Sunday 2:00pm show:** Dancers arrive between 1:00-1:30pm. Show begins @ 2:00pm.  
Doors open to the public @ 1:00pm.

\*\* EACH Dance Expressions class, and all solos/duets/trios/small groups are in ONE show. All regular classes are in two (2) of the four (4) shows.

**ALL DANCERS ARE TO ARRIVE IN THE FRONT DOORS FOR THE PERFORMANCES!!! NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO COME THROUGH THE BACK GARAGE DOORS.** Dancers will be checked in at the new 'bar' area called 'Backstage at the Meyer'. This room is located DIRECTLY TO THE LEFT OF THE FRONT DOORS next to the ticket office (once inside).

NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE WITH THEIR CHILDREN. All parents, relatives, guardians, visitors, etc. must leave their children with the chaperones at this point. There will be POD staff members and volunteers at the entrance to direct the students (or escort the little ones) to their appropriate dressing room. There will also be parents and volunteers in each dressing room for supervision and assistance with costume changes.

**All dancers need to arrive at the Meyer Theatre for performances** with hair and makeup done for their first routine. **Shows will begin promptly at their respective times.** In which case, please remember that the kids have time to spare. We would like them to be prepared to wait. Books, puzzles, ipods (all labeled with names of course) are welcome backstage. We estimate that the entire recital will be approximately 2 ½ - 3 hours long. (Again, provided things go smoothly☺) Parents can attend as many shows as you would like and are NOT required to attend every show your children are in; however, you will need to drop off and pick up your children promptly if you are not in attendance for the entire program. Front doors will open at the end of the show so you can enter and pick up your child if needed.

**\*Dance Expressions ONLY– Can be dropped off upstairs the main entrance to the Meyer. There will be a 'check in' on the second floor. It is the room directly above the lobby. D.E. WILL BE dismissed at the intermission, also on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.** This will be approximately half way through each production. Please DO NOT pick up your child early as volunteers are instructed not to allow the children to leave. **If you plan on staying for the remainder of the show(s), you will have to purchase a ticket for your child/dancer in order to re-enter the main auditorium with your dance expressions dancer. This should be done ahead of time.** If you, or the person picking up your child, did not purchase a ticket to attend the show, you will be asked to leave following your child's dismissal. ONLY children 2yrs and younger are allowed to sit on a parents lap during the program(s).

**All other students will be dismissed AFTER the entire program either in the auditorium or “Backstage at the Meyer” (the bar area you dropped them off at).**

Students need to ‘check out’ with their class supervisor prior to leaving the building. This is to ensure each child is accounted for and not going home with anyone other than who they came with. If you are sending your child/ren home with another family, please send your child along with a note stating who they are to be released with so that the class supervisors know.

**\*\* ABSOLUTELY NO PARENTS OR VISITORS ARE ALLOWED BACKSTAGE PRIOR TO, FOLLOWING, OR DURING PERFORMANCES! THIS IS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE STUDENTS, VOLUNTEERS, AND STAFF. ANY VIOLATIONS ARE STRICKLY PROHIBITED AND SECURITY WILL BE NOTIFIED IMMEDIATELY! \*\***

Out of respect for the Meyer Theatre staff, we ask that if you take pictures after the performance, you do so quickly. Many of the Meyer Theatre staff are volunteers and would like to be timely in getting home to their own families.

**\*\*For you and your family’s convenience, flowers, refreshments, and studio attire will be sold at the Meyer Theatre.**

## **TICKET INFORMATION:**

**TICKETS WILL GO ON SALE Monday, APRIL 3<sup>rd</sup> AT 11:00AM!**

*Please be very careful to make sure you are looking at the correct class and check each list before ordering tickets. Tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable. POD will not re-sell tickets purchased by mistake. ONLY children 2yrs and younger are allowed to sit on a parent lap during the program(s).*

**Tickets: All tickets are reserved seating! On-Sale April 3<sup>rd</sup> through TicketStar and the Resch Center Box Office. Tickets are the same price for Children and Adults. The Ticket Star office is located inside the Resch Center located at: 1901 S Oneida St, Green Bay, WI 54304.**

**Ticket Cost:** \$12.00 Orchestra and Grand Tier & \$9.50 Mezzanine (if purchased through Resch Center Box office or directly from the Meyer Theatre the night of the event.)

The dancers do not need a ticket the nights they are performing due to that they are backstage with their classes and a chaperon for the entire program. Other studios may do this differently, yet we have been praised by the Meyer Theatre staff on how well we keep track of our kids and our security. So, for those shows your dancer is in, he/she will be back with the other dancers. You don't need to attend the shows if you'd prefer not to; however, if you do, you will need a ticket. All the seats/tickets are reserved seating. If you are just simply dropping off you dancer with the chaperons and leaving until he/she is finished, then that is fine to. You will not need a ticket just to pick up your dancer at the end of each program.
