Thank you for your patience as we work through the details of our end of the year Spring Production. Although it is still a work in progress, we wanted to give you the information that we DO know; much of which became available as of Monday. In this ever-changing atmosphere, please be aware that we are hoping these details remain constant through next weekend. If they do not, we will let you know immediately.

Where: Green Bay Community Church - (600 Cardinal Ln #6731, Green Bay, WI 54313)

When: Friday, June 26th & Saturday, June 27th

How: Dress Rehearsal Style (please see the "Directions for Day Of")

Safety precautions:

- Masks are not mandatory, yet appreciated for anyone not on stage and performing. If students would prefer to wear a mask while performing, they are more than welcome to. That is up to the individual's parents' discretion.
- Temperatures of all dancers and spectators will be taken at the door upon arrival.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at stations throughout the part of the facility POD is using.
- Restrooms on the West side of the building (by the main entrance) are open and encouraged to be used for frequent hand washing.
- Students with costume changes will utilize designated areas to ensure social distancing.

DIRECTIONS FOR THE 'DAY OF': WHAT TO EXPECT UPON ARRIVAL TO DEPARTURE

PARK ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE CAMPUS (This is the entrance off of Cardinal). You will enter the doors facing that parking lot, which are also the main doors to GBCC.

Due to social distancing, we ask that you do not go into GBCC too early. Dawn will be stationed outside with a board that indicates when it is appropriate to allow the next class inside the building. Provided there is nice weather, we do not mind waiting outside the front doors. In the event of inclement weather, we will stick strictly by the schedule so as to ensure not too many bodies inside the building at one time.

Staff will be at the doors to greet you, take temperatures, and direct families where to go.

Dancers should arrive IN COSTUME of the first routine they will be dancing on stage with. If the dancer is in only one routine, ARRIVE IN THAT COSTUME. If the dancer is in multiple routines and they are able to be scheduled close together, a dressing space will be assigned. Hair and makeup should be done and stage ready. Street shoes can be taken off and dancers change into dance shoes once in the building.

Classes will be slotted times throughout the day(s) and receive 10 + minutes on the 'stage' to allow them to do each routine twice, if needed. Some classes are very well versed with being on stage and/or their routine and may only run through their song once. That's great! If so, we will move onto the next routine provided everyone is there at the designated "arrive at GBCC" time listed on the line up.

Due to capacity restrictions and safety precautions, there will be no seating. As of Monday, we were told we could increase capacity to 25% or less. Please keep in mind, this percentage is in terms of the space *available* to us, not the entire facility. Therefore due to space, we ask families to limit spectators to 2 PER DANCER.

- Those spectators, will need to arrive and depart with the dancer. POD will direct families where to go to view the routines. Spectators will be asked to exit the building with their dancer, when their dancer is dismissed. This will allow for our next group of spectators to come in and provide adequate viewing room and maintain social distancing.

Since viewing space is limited to the sides of the room, we know it is not ideal and spectators may not be standing on the same 'side' of which your dancer is performing. NOT TO WORRY!!! The Power of Dance is covering any costs associated with next weekend's event, and we are providing a professional videographer, who will be taping down the center of the room. These professional videos will be compiled into one complete "Recital" for a virtual production to be enjoyed for purchase with family and friends (at a later date), AND/OR in one complete DVD. Just as our annual recital DVD's would be.

Each class, with the exception of ballets, should last no longer than 15 min. Ballets are estimated longer due to the length of their performances.

Provided our students follow directions and are ready when called, we anticipate things going smoothly. **Please be prepared if rehearsals run early. This could happen if there is nice weather and temperature checks can be done outside the facility.** In the event that there may be some snags, which may lengthen our time at rehearsal, please send your child(ren) with books, IPAD, something to do in the car, etc. Please make sure your child's NAME is on all items that are brought into GBCC. POD and GBCC are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
