Our Senior team wants to watch your kids from 5:30 pm until 9:00 pm on October 23rd. They have a Trunk or Treat, as well as, craft, activities and chill areas set up to entertain your kids. All you need to do is fill out the attached registration form and return it to POD as soon as possible for planning purposes. We've included an early bird discount for your help. Then just drop your little ghosts and goblins off, preferably in their Halloween Costume for a costume contest and go enjoy a few hours to yourself.

We have designed this event to make it as safe as possible with respect to Covid restrictions. We ask that all kids wear masks unless they have medical exemptions and the kids will only be moving in one direction and will spend part of a rotation going trick or treating at our trunk or treat cars. If your child ends up on quarantine or with Covid and you have already registered don't worry we will be happy to refund your money. Please don't send your child if they are sick.

We have a few asks for the event.....

- Please send your child/ren in slip on shoes with their name on a piece of masking tape across the toes. This will aid us in the trunk or treat portion of their night.
- When you drop your child/ren off we ask that you enter from Lineville, come down past Terry Naturally and just pull up and stop in front of the studio doors. You do not need to park! We will have volunteers and the Senior team there to meet your children at your vehicle and escort them to their studio door. Kids will be split up by age groups.
- When you pick your child/ren up after please park and then pick them up at the studio door that will be marked with age groups. No children will be released to anyone other than a parent unless you let us know prior.
- Please feed your child/ren dinner prior as we will only be providing a light snack and they should bring a water bottle marked with their name on it.
